

Present

A Meeting of persons interested in the erection of an Anglican Church at Tindooorooopilly was held in the Wesleyan Church, Tindooorooopilly on Wednesday January 10th 1888 at 8 o'clock in the evening. The Local Bishop of the diocese presided, and there were also present the Rev C. W. Houlbrook M.A. Rector of the parish, Rev J. S. Hastings Vicar of Sherwood, and the following gentlemen, Messrs G. L. Hart, Day, Neilson, Cannon, Strong, Bolton, Burston, L. Sembley, Scott, and Rolston.

The Meeting having been opened with prayer by the Rector, the Bishop briefly explained the objects of the Meeting, and spoke of the necessity of Church accommodation being ^{provided} for such a large and growing district.

The Rev C. W. Houlbrook gave a brief account of the Church Work done in the district during the past two years and explained that it had been first intended to build the Tindooorooopilly Church on land kindly offered by Captain Boyle Logg on his estate at Witton. This was subsequently considered to be not sufficiently central for the whole district, and ~~the~~ G. L. Hart Logg then offered a half-acre block fronting the Main road near Tindooorooopilly Railway Station to the Corporation of the Syndic as the site for the






















